WHAT TO EXPECT DURING YOUR TASTING EXPERIENCE

The health and wellbeing of our customers and staff remains our top priority. We will be following all state and industry guidelines and taking precautions to help ensure the safety of our customers and staff. Just as before, your tasting experience will include delicious wine, tableside service and the company of friends and family. Here's what to expect when you arrive for your next tasting experience:

- Reservations will be required for all tasting experiences.
- Face coverings will be required when you arrive and depart. While seated, coverings can be removed to enjoy wine service.
- All tastings will be held outdoors.
- Each seated tasting experience will last for 1 hour.
- Shared tastings will not be offered at this time.
- Cash will not be accepted in the tasting room. To minimize contact we will be transitioning to credit cards only.
- Reservations cannot be extended for additional times or merged with other guest's reservations.
- No outside food or beverages are permitted.

HEALTH & WELLNESS

- All employees will wear face coverings at all times during your experience.
- Additional sanitization measures will be utilized before and after each tasting.
- All Bridlewood Estate Winery team members will be participating in regular health checks and have completed a variety of trainings.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Proper social distancing is an important element of our new tasting experience and we have taken many steps to make this easy for our customers and employees:

- All staff will maintain a six-foot distance from other staff and customers.
- Seating arrangements have been redesigned to ensure there is more than six feet of space between tables, and throughout our entry and exit spaces.

NEW CAPACITY STANDARDS

To support social distancing efforts, we will be limiting our total capacity, while still ensuring that time spent with your party is enjoyable and memorable. These new standards include:

- Parties will be limited to no more than six people. While we ask guests to maintain six feet of distance from other parties, those in the same group do not have to socially distance.
- Our interior Member's Lounge will be temporarily closed to allow for proper staff distancing for wine and service preparation.
- All guests must be 21 years or older.
- No dogs or other animals are permitted at this time.

We are so grateful for your support and patience as we navigate this new experience together. As we continue to make necessary adjustments, we will always remain focused on a safe and enjoyable experience full of delicious wine, great company and an unforgettable view.
